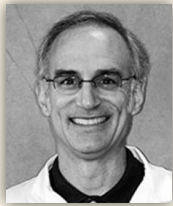

John Orsi D.D.S. is a 1983 UOP graduate with a private dental practice in Sacramento. He received advanced training through mini-residencies in both Sleep Medicine at UCLA and Orofacial pain at both UCLA and Rutgers School of Dental Medicine, New Jersey. In 2013 he completed a one-year preceptor in the Orofacial Pain program at UCLA Dental School after which he received a two-year board certification process in orofacial pain while maintaining his private practice in Sacramento. He is a guest lecturer and clinical floor instructor for the UCLA graduate program in orofacial pain.

Kenneth E. Moore, DDS graduated from UCSF in 1982 and is a general dentist and an Orofacial Pain specialist in Roseville, California. Dr. Moore is the Associate Director of the UCLA Orofacial Pain and Sleep Medicine post-graduate program. He is also the co-director of both the TMD/Orofacial Pain and the Integrative Medicine/Dental Acupuncture mini-residency programs at UCLA. Dr. Moore has attended various continuums at the L.D. Pankey Institute, Spear Institute, Kois Center, and the Dawson Academy.

Course synopsis: An overview of Orofacial Pain introducing concepts that will help dentists recognize multiple types of nonodontogenic pain, improve effectiveness of TMD treatment, avoid iatrogenic treatment, and possibly save a life. Have you ever heard of a patient coming in for a toothache and needing more than one root canal? Or the root canal treatment looks perfect, but the patient still has pain? Have you ever seen patients with many root canals and/or extractions only on one side? You will learn ways to keep your patients safe and prevent working on a tooth that is only a symptom, not the problem.
